## Four major themes about the future of the online social climate

**Theme 1:** Things will stay bad because to troll is human; trolls have been with us since the dawn of time; there will always be some incivility

**Theme 2:** Things will stay bad because tangible and intangible economic and political incentives support trolling; hate, anxiety, and anger drive participation; participation = power and profits

**Theme 3:** Things will get better because technical and human solutions will arise; Al sentiment analysis and other tools will detect inappropriate behavior and many trolls will be caught in the filter; human oversights by moderators might catch others

Theme 4: Oversight and community moderation could come with a cost
